This provides all team members with valuable opportunities to practice and hone necessary skill development and refinement, and complements the time that synchronized skaters have for team practice. For more information on skating programs, please consult your singles coach.

This season, skaters must achieve their <u>STAR 1 Skills assessment by October 15, 2019</u>, in order to compete with the Elementary team. Registrations will be returned if there are outstanding fees from previous NBSC sessions or any other registered Skate Canada club. Skaters will not be permitted on the ice, nor will they be allowed to participate in skating tests.
